*Former Legal Advisor of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Sri Lanka
Chairman of the Ad Hoc Committee established by
General Assembly resolution 51/210 of 17 December 1996 (terrorism)*

Dr. A. Rohan Perera P.C. served until recently as the Legal Advisor of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Sri Lanka. During a career spanning thirty-two (32) years he has negotiated on behalf of the Government of Sri Lanka a range of bi-lateral and multilateral treaties covering diverse subjects such as foreign trade and investment, maritime boundary regimes, mutual legal assistance and extradition. He now serves as an Advisor on International Legal Affairs to the Ministry of foreign Affairs of Sri Lanka.

Dr. Perera is currently a member of the International Law Commission (ILC).

Dr. Perera is also the Chairman of the United Nations Ad Hoc Committee established by General Assembly resolution 51/210 of 17 December 1996 (measures to eliminate international terrorism), which is currently negotiating a draft Comprehensive Convention on Terrorism.

Dr. Perera is a visiting lecturer in International Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Colombo, Bandaranaike International Diplomatic Training Institute, Kotalawala Defence Academy and Staff Command College. He has also published several books on international law and contributed articles on international law topics to local and foreign Law Journals.
