

**JUDGE VLADLEN S. VERESHCHETIN**

*Former Member of the International Court of Justice*

*Honorary Director of the International Institute of Space Law*

Judge V.S. Vereshchetin served as a Member of the International Court of Justice in 1995-2006. Before that he was a member and Chairman of the International Law Commission, Member of the Permanent Court of Arbitration. He is Professor of International Law (Institute of State and Law of the Russian Academy of Sciences), Doctor of Juridical Sciences, Maître émérite des Sciences of the Russian Federation (title bestowed by the President of the State), and Honorary Director of the International Institute of Space Law. He is also a member of several national and international academies, including the International Academy of Astronautics. He served as Vice-Chairman and Legal Counsel, INERCOSMOS, Russian Academy of Sciences: Deputy-Director and Head of the International Law Department of the Institute of State and Law (Moscow): Member of the USSR delegations to the UN Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and its Legal Sub-Committee. He has published widely in the area of international law, in particular the law of outer space, international judicial settlement and the theory of international law.
