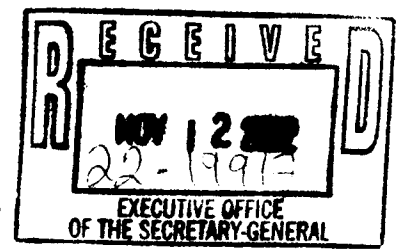

The Permanent Representative of Mongolia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to his letter NUB/187/02 dated 10 September, 2002 with respect to the Mongolian candidate for a post as a Judge of the International Criminal Court (ICC), has the honor to make the following additional statement in compliance with Article 36.4(a) of the Rome Statute of the ICC and paragraph 7 of the Resolution of the Assembly of States Parties relating to the procedure for the nomination and elections of Judges, the Prosecutor and Deputy Prosecutor of the ICC:

1. Candidate Dr. J. Enkhsaikhan has been nominated for inclusion in list B for the purposes of Article 36.5, since he has established competence and experience in relevant areas of international law, including human rights and humanitarian law.
2. His nomination has been made in Mongolia in accordance with the procedure envisaged in Article 36.4 (a) (i).
3. Dr. Enkhsaikhan masters the English language as is required by Article 36.3 (c). He also has the working knowledge of the French, Russian and Spanish languages.
4. He represents a country with a mixed legal system (continental and common law legal systems).
5. Dr. Enkhsaikhan is male and is a national of Mongolia, a member of the Asian Group at the United Nations.

The Permanent Representative of Mongolia to the United Nations avails himself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary General of the United Nations the assurances of his highest consideration.
