Sir,


I have the honour to refer to a telephone query from your office on 21 November 2002 regarding the nomination of the former Chief Justice of Fiji, Sir Timoci Uluiburotu Tuivaga Kt, CF, CSM as a judge of the International Criminal Court at the elections which will be held in New York on February 2003.

I have further the honour to refer to the Statement that we had submitted on 12 November 2002 in accordance with Article 36, paragraph 4 (a) of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court and paragraph 7 of the resolution of the Assembly of States Parties relating to the procedure for the nomination and election of judges, the Prosecutor and Deputy Prosecutors of the International Criminal Court, and would like to draw your attention to the following amendments:

- First paragraph of first page should read "Statement of Sir Timoci Uluiburotu Tuivaga Kt, CF, CSM, former Chief Justice of Fiji submitted in accordance with Article 36 of the Rome Statement of the International Criminal Court..... ["paragraph 4 (a)" after "Article 36" has been deleted], and
- The national nomination procedure used in this selection is pursuant to Article 36(4)(a)(i) which has been added to page 9.

To effect these changes, replacement to pages 1 and 9 are enclosed containing the noted amendments.
