ARTICLE 38

TEXT OF ARTICLE 38

Without prejudice to the provisions of Articles 33 to 37, the Security Council may, if all the parties to any dispute so request, make recommendations to the parties with a view to a pacific settlement of the dispute.

NOTE

As in the previous period, there has been no instance of the request by all the parties to a dispute to the Security Council under the provisions of Article 50, nor has there been a decision by the Council requiring treatment under this Article.
