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This map illustrates the part of the delimitation line from the Beleso to the headwater of Muna in the Central Sector between Eritrea and Ethiopia as described in Chapter VIII.19 of the Decision of the Eritrea-Ethiopia Boundary Commission of 13 April 2002. The coordinates of the line and its turning points are subject to adjustment during demarcation.

SPOT panchromatic images of 10-metre resolution (captured in November 1999 and November 2001, CNES 2002) have been orthorectified and used as the background image. Geographic information, with the exception of names, has been extracted from these images.
