[*Article 50 (a)*. — An Extraordinary Session of the Assembly met at United Nations Headquarters in New York on 11-12 March, and, on 12 March, adopted an amendment increasing the number of seats in the Council from 27 to 30.⁶² The amendment not having come into force at the time of the 18th session of the Assembly (June-July), that body considered the question whether to proceed with the selection of three States to fill the three seats added by the amendment to Article 50 (*a*) when the amendment would eventually come into force, and reached a negative decision. However, the Assembly did invite Contracting States which had not already done so to ratify the amendment to Article 50 (*a*) as a matter of urgency and requested the Council to convene an Extraordinary Session of the Assembly to fill the three additional seats as soon as possible after the deposit of the eightieth instrument of ratification if it considered such action opportune at that time.

Article 56. — During its 18th session, the Assembly adopted, on 5 July, an amendment to Article 56 of the Convention increasing the number of seats on the Air Navigation Commission from 12 to 15.⁶³

Article 7. — A proposal of Sweden for the deletion of the second sentence of Article 7 came before the 18th session of the Assembly. Though the Executive Committee, on a simple majority vote, recommended the adoption of the amendment, the two-thirds vote prescribed in Article 94 (*a*) of the Convention was not obtained in the plenary.]

(2) SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES BETWEEN CONTRACTING STATES— PAKISTAN *versus* INDIA

[India having suspended the flights of Pakistani aircraft over its territory, the Government of Pakistan, on 10 March 1971, filed with the Organization an application under Article 2 of the Rules for the Settlement of Differences (Doc 7782). This application related, inter alia, to "disagreements" between the two Governments in the sense of clauses (*a*) and (*b*) of paragraph (1) of Article 1 of the Rules for the Settlement of Differences. On 8 April the Council invited the two parties immediately to negotiate directly for the purpose of settling the dispute or narrowing the issues; decided, subject to the consent of the parties concerned, to render any assistance likely to further the negotiations; and fixed at eight weeks the period within which India was invited to present its counter-memorial.

Also, on 10 March 1971, the Government of Pakistan filed with the Organization a complaint under Article 21 of the Rules for the Settlement of Differences. The President of the Council, acting under Article 28 (3) of the Rules fixed an eight-week period for the filing of the counter-memorial relating to the complaint.

On 1 June, India filed preliminary objections in which it questioned the jurisdiction of the Council to handle the above-mentioned disagreements and complaint. Pakistan's reply to the preliminary objections was dated 5 July. After hearing arguments of India and Pakistan from 27 to 29 July, the Council on 29 July, rejected the preliminary objections and hence reaffirmed its competence to consider the application and complaint of Pakistan.

X. INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

1. STATUTE AND MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Action taken by States in connection with the Statute

- (a) The Agency's membership at the end of 1971 stood at 102.
- (b) The official designation of the "United Arab Republic" was changed to "The Arab Republic of Egypt" with effect from 2 September 1971.
- (c) The official designation of "The Democratic Republic of the Congo" was changed to "The Republic of Zaire" with effect from 27 October 1971.
- (d) By 31 December 1971, 23 of the 102 Member States of the Agency had accepted the amendment to Article VI.A—D of the Statute of the Agency. This amendment has been approved by the General Conference of the IAEA on 28 September 1970 by Resolution GC(XIV)/RES/272.⁶⁶ It will enter into force when it has been accepted by two-thirds of all the Members in accordance with their respective constitutional processes, as provided for by Article XVIII.C.(ii) of the Statute.
