Michał Balcerzak is an Associate Professor at the Department of International Security, Faculty of Political Science and Security Studies, Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, as well as an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Szczecin, Poland. Since 2022, he has been serving as Member and Vice-Chairperson at the United Nations Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination (CERD). Within the CERD Committee, he is a member of the Working Groups for Early Warning and Urgent Action (EWUA), and the Working Groups for Individual Communications. He also serves as a conciliator at the Ad Hoc Conciliation Commission on the inter-State communication *State of Palestine vs. Israel* (established under article 12 of the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination). He is also a member of the International Law Association (ILA Polish Branch) and a member of the ILA's Committee on Human Rights in Times of Emergency.

He served as an *ad hoc* judge at the European Court of Human Rights (2018-2022) and was an alternate member of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights (2012-2016). Earlier in his career, he was a member of the United Nations Working Group of Experts on People of African Descent (special procedure of the Human Rights Council, 2014-2021, chairperson of the Group 2018-2019). He took part in various inter-governmental expert activities within the Council of Europe, including at the Steering Committee on Human Rights (2004-2008), and working groups drafting recommendations of the Committee of Ministers concerning the protection of human rights in accelerated asylum procedures (GT-DH-AS, 2006-2009), human rights of members of armed forces (DH-DEV-FA, 2007-2009) and combatting impunity for serious human rights violations (DH-I, 2009-2011).

He is the author of circa a hundred publications on international law, including on the protection of human rights, international State responsibility and international judiciary. Between 2017 and 2020, he was editor-in-chief of *Comparative Law Review*. He is also an advocate and member of the Warsaw Bar Association.
