

MR. NIELS BLOKKER

Niels Blokker is professor of the law of international organizations at the Grotius Centre for International Legal Studies, Leiden University, the Netherlands.

He graduated from Leiden University (1984), where he also defended his dissertation (1989). From 1984 he was a lecturer, subsequently a senior lecturer in the law of international organizations at Leiden University. In 2003 he was appointed as part-time Professor of International Institutional Law to the Schermers Chair. Since August 2013 he is holding this Chair on a fulltime basis.

In 2000 Niels Blokker was appointed senior legal counsel at the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs. From 2007 until August 2013 he was deputy legal adviser at this Ministry.

Niels Blokker has published books and articles on a variety of international law issues, in particular related to the law of international organizations. With the late Henry G. Schermers, he is the co-author of *International Institutional Law* (5th edition published in 2011). He is also co-founder and co-editor in chief of the *International Organizations Law Review*.
