Her past professional experience includes academic teaching and working as an attorney at the Brussels Bar. Mrs Boelaert has served as legal adviser with the High Commissioner for Refugees in Rwanda and with IFAD and FAO in Rome, and from 1989 to 2003 she was a legal adviser and prosecutor with the International Criminal Tribunals for the former Yugoslavia and Rwanda.

In 2004 Mrs Boelaert joined the European Union institutions. She is currently a senior legal adviser with the Council of the European Union. In that capacity she regularly appears before the Court of Justice of the European Union in Luxemburg. She has also been in charge of litigation outside EU courts and has appeared before the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea in Hamburg.
