Helen Durham is Director of International Law and Policy at the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) headquarters in Geneva. In her role she oversees a large global network of international lawyers, policy advisers, armed forces and police delegates, weapons specialists, sociologists, researchers and academic experts who work towards the respect of international humanitarian law.

Admitted as a Barrister and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Victoria and High Court of Australia, Ms. Durham previously worked as the Legal Adviser for the ICRC Regional Delegation for the Pacific and was Head of Office for ICRC Australia. She has also acted as Director of Research for the Asia Pacific Centre for Military Law. She is widely published on international humanitarian law topics, having been involved in ICRC operational work in the field (in Myanmar, Aceh, the Philippines and the Pacific) and part of negotiations for international treaties in New York, Geneva and Rome.
