

MR. PIET EECKHOUT

Professor of European Law

Piet Eeckhout studied law and European law at the University of Ghent, Belgium, where he also obtained his PhD degree. Before joining King's College London in 1998 he taught at the University of Ghent and at the University of Brussels (VUB). Between 1994 and 1998 he worked in the chambers of Advocate General Jacobs at the European Court of Justice.

Professor Eeckhout was Director of the Centre of European Law, at King's College London, between 1998 and 2012, when he joined UCL. He has been co-editor of the Yearbook of European Law, and is co-editor of the Oxford EU Law Library and of Current Legal Problems (all Oxford University Press).

Professor Eeckhout is a leading authority in EU law and international economic law. He is the author of EU External Relations Law (2nd ed, Oxford University Press 2011). In 2004 he delivered the General Course at the Academy of European Law, Florence, and in 2006 he was General Rapporteur at the biennial FIDE (Federation of European Law Associations) Conference.
