Professor Malgosia Fitzmaurice holds a chair of public international law at Queen Mary University of London. She specializes in international environmental law, whaling, indigenous rights and the law of treaties, on all of these subjects she publishes extensively. Her monograph on “Whaling and International Law” was published by Cambridge University Press in December 2015. In 2001 she delivered The Hague Academy of International lecture on “The International Protection of the Environment”. Professor Fitzmaurice was invited several times as a Visiting Professor by numerous universities, such as IMO International Maritime Law Institute in Malta (Nippon Foundation Professor); UC Berkeley School of Law, University of Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, and University of Kobe, Japan.
