Ms. Galenskaya was born on 1 October 1932 in Vitebsk, USSR.

She graduated from the Faculty of Law, Leningrad State University in 1954. She then worked as an arbitrator at the State Arbitration Court, an investigator at the Public Prosecution Office and as a legal adviser.

In 1965, she obtained a Candidate of legal sciences and began to work as an assistant at the Law Faculty of Leningrad State University. She then worked as a docent at the same Faculty and in 1980 obtained a degree of Doctor of Juridical Science and the academic rank of Professor.

She currently teaches courses on “International Private Law” and the “Application of the Rules of International Law in the Arbitration and Judicial Practice of the Russian Federation”.

Her main subjects of scientific interest are the following: international institutional system, legal regulation of international cultural relations, problems of international private law.

She is the author of over 700 publications, including 7 monographs and the editor-in-chief of the Russian Yearbook of International Law and the Journal of International Private Law. Visited many foreign Universities, including The Hague Academy of International Law. She is a personal member of such international organization as the International Law Association. She is a member of Legal Counsel of the Supreme Arbitration Court of the Russian Federation, a member of the Adviser Counsel at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, and the Chairman of the Arbitration Court of the North-Western Association of the Banks.
