Vera Gowlland-Debbas is Professor of Public International Law at the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies in Geneva. She has been an Honorary Professor at University College London (UCL), a Visiting Fellow at All Souls College, Oxford, and a Visiting Professor at Université Panthéon-Assas Paris II and at the University of California at Berkeley. Her publications have spanned the fields of UN Law, Security Council sanctions, refugee and human rights law, multilateral treaty-making, state responsibility and international courts. She has been particularly concerned with issues of accountability of international organisations and her 2007 course at the Hague Academy of International Law focused on issues of responsibility arising from the decisions of the Security Council. She has also worked as a practitioner, advising states, institutions and law firms, and was involved, as Counsel for the Arab League, in the ICJ Wall Opinion.
