Jan Klabbers is Professor of International Law at the University of Helsinki, where until recently he was also of International Organisations Law and Director of the Centre of Excellence in Global Governance Research. He is also Deputy Director of the Erik Castren Institute of International Law and Human Rights. He previously held positions at the University of Amsterdam. His many publications include *The Concept of Treaty in International Law* (The Hague: Kluwer, 1996), *An Introduction to International Institutional Law* (Cambridge University Press, 2002, second edition 2009), *Treaty Conflict and the European Union* (Cambridge University Press, 2009) and (with Anne Peters and Geir Ulfstein) *The Constitutionalization of International Law* (OUP 2009).

Professor Klabbers has also held visiting professorships/fellowships at a number of institutions, Hofstra University School of Law (2007), the Graduate Institute for International Studies and Development, Geneva (2008), the Straus Institute for the Advanced Study of Law and Justice, New York University Law School (2009-10), and the University of Paris Pantheon-Assas (Paris II; 2011).
