Franck Latty is a professor ‘agrégé’ at Paris Nanterre University. He is the director of the CEDIN (Center of international law of Nanterre). He teaches and publishes on issues of general international law (sources of international law, law of international responsibility, law of international organisations, law of peace keeping and use of force etc.), the law of foreign investments and sports law. His PhD thesis (2005, under the supervision of Pr Alain Pellet) was on ‘Lex sportiva – Research into transnational law’ (published, in French, in 2007, Martinus Nijhoff).

Franck Latty is the secretary general of the French Branch of the International Law Association (ILA). He is also vice-president of the French-speaking network of international law (RFDI, in charge of the Charles-Rousseau moot court). He is a member of the board of the French Society for international law (SFDI). He is also acting as a conciliator and arbitrator in sports cases under the auspices of the French Olympic Committee (CNOSF)
