He worked as a lawyer of the Advisory Office for the Law of the Sea (2012-2014) and as a legal specialist of the Legal Advisory Office of the same Ministry (2014-2015).

He was a researcher of the Institute of International Studies (IDEI) of the Pontifical Catholic University of Peru (2005-2009 and 2010-2011).

He was legal adviser of the official delegation of Peru before the International Court of Justice during the oral hearings of the maritime dispute case (*Peru v. Chile*), in December 2012.

He was a participant of the Centre for Studies and Research of the Hague Academy of International Law (2017) and of the Seminar of the International Law Commission (2014).

He is a Commander (*Comendador*) of the Order of Merit of the Diplomatic Service of Peru, awarded in 2015 for his services during maritime dispute case (*Peru v. Chile*) before the International Court of Justice.
