David Pavot is an Associate Professor of International Law and the Chairholder of the Research Chair in Responsible Sport at the University of Sherbrooke (Canada). He previously held the Research Chair in Anti-Doping in Sport. His research focuses on international sports law (anti-doping, the interaction between human rights and sport, and international economic law as it relates to sport), as well as key aspects of general international law (immunities, the legal status of international organizations, and host State agreements).

He is the author of over 80 publications and has delivered more than 100 presentations at academic conferences since the beginning of his career. In addition to his academic work, he serves as a consultant for various organizations, including the Government of Quebec, World Athletics, and the World Anti-Doping Agency. He is also a member of the international panel of arbitrators for Sport Resolutions, and sits on vetting panels for World Boxing and PanAm Boxing.

Since April 2024, he has served as President of the Quebec Society of International Law.
