Brigadier Kevin Riordan is Deputy Chief Judge of the Court Martial of New Zealand, Deputy Judge Advocate General of the Armed Forces of New Zealand and Adjunct Lecturer in Law at Victoria University of Wellington. Since graduation and admission to the bar Kevin has filled number of legal positions in the New Zealand Defence Force and has provided advice on international law, the law of armed conflict, peace-support operations and counter-terrorism. His duties have included deployment to South East Asia, Bougainville, the Middle East, Bosnia-Herzegovina and Afghanistan. Kevin was a member of the New Zealand delegation to the Rome Conference on the International Criminal Court, subsequent preparatory conferences on the elements of crimes and the ICC Review Conference in Kampala. He has also been part of New Zealand's involvement in the development of international law in respect of conventional weapons and the banning of cluster munitions. Kevin is a graduate of Victoria University of Wellington and holds a Master of Laws degree from Cornell University. In 2004 Kevin was appointed an officer of the New Zealand Order of Merit. He has written a number of manuals on operational law, the law of armed conflict and war crimes.
