

MR. HI-TAEK SHIN

Professor of International Investment Law, Seoul National University School of Law

Hi-Taek Shin is a professor of law at Seoul National University School of Law and the director of the Center for International Economic and Business Law at Seoul National University. He is an expert in international investment law and cross-border M&A transactions.

Mr. Shin received his LL.B and LL.M from Seoul National University. After being admitted to the Korean bar, Mr. Shin pursued advanced legal studies at Yale Law School, where he received the LL.M and JSD degrees in the area of international investment law.

Prior to joining the law faculty at Seoul National University, Mr. Shin was a partner at the leading Korean law firm of Kim & Chang where he specialized in mergers and acquisitions, and foreign direct investment, with particular emphasis on cross-border transactions, for more than 25 years. Mr. Shin has extensive experience in representing multinational investors doing business in Korea and advising Korean conglomerates seeking to invest overseas. Mr. Shin is internationally distinguished as one of the best M&A lawyers by reputable publications.

Mr. Shin actively advises the Korean government on issues relating to the negotiations of many important international agreements. Among his prolific services to the Korean government, he assisted the Korean government in the negotiation of GATS during the Uruguay Round and recently served as co-chairman of the commission to review investor-state arbitration provisions in the Korea-US FTA negotiation. He also served as the director of the Korean Bar Association for international relations. He is also serving as a member of the Presidential Advisory Commission on the National Economic Policy.
