He is the author of *Great Powers and Outlaw States* (Cambridge, 2004) and *Law, War and Crime: War Crimes Trials and the Reinvention of International Law* (Polity 2007). His latest book, *The Margins of International Law* (a collection of his essays), will be published by Cameron and May in 2012. He is currently working on a book about the literary life of international law.
