

MS. MIA SWART

Professor of International Law

Faculty of Law, University of Johannesburg

Prof. Mia Swart coordinates and teaches the LLM programme in international law at the University of Johannesburg. Mia previously worked as Research Fellow at the Bingham Centre for the Rule of Law in London and as Assistant Professor of Public International law and Global Justice at Leiden University, from which she earned her Ph.D in 2006. She also holds the title of Honorary Associate Professor at the University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg where she previously worked as Associate Professor. Mia focuses her academic research on transitional justice, international criminal law, and comparative constitutional law. In 2007 and 2009, Mia received a Humboldt research fellowship to do research at the Max Planck Institute in Freiburg and at Berlin's Humboldt University, from which she holds an LL.M. She worked as an intern in the Appeals Chamber of the ICTY in 2001, the same year she was admitted as an attorney. Mia chairs the Complementarity Committee of the International Law Association. She consulted for the United Nations Development Programme in Palestine and Amnesty International in Southern Africa. She regularly contributes to the media.
