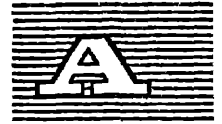

UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON THE ELIMINATION  
OR REDUCTION OF FUTURE STATELESSNESS

FRANCE: Amendment to article 1, paragraph 2, adopted by the Committee  
of the Whole and revised by the Drafting Committee (A/CONF.9/L.40)

Add the following sub-paragraph to article 1, paragraph 2:

- (c) that the person concerned has not given evidence of manifest unworthiness, such as activities detrimental to national security or his having been sentenced to imprisonment for a term of not less than five years, for a criminal act; provided, however, that the acquisition of nationality may not be disallowed under the present sub-paragraph until after an independent body has been consulted.
