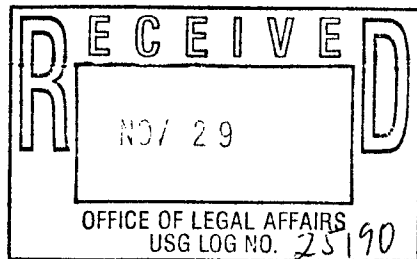
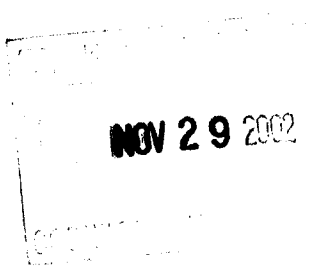
The Permanent Mission of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General, and has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that the procedure followed for the nomination of Mr Adrian Fulford QC as a candidate for election as a judge of the International Criminal Court followed that for the nomination of candidates for appointment to the highest judicial offices in England, Wales and Northern Ireland (Article 36.4(a)(1) of the ICC Statute). The United Kingdom used a transparent process involving advertisements and a panel of senior members of the judiciary of England and Wales, and Scotland, senior officials and a representative of civil society, who made recommendations to the Lord Chancellor.

The Permanent Mission of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General the assurance of its highest considerations.
