LETTER DATED 23 MARCH 1970 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE CHAIRMAN
OF THE INTERNATIONAL LAW COMMISSION

I have the honour to refer to General Assembly resolution 2499 A (XXIV) of 31 October 1969, on the celebration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the United Nations. In its operative paragraph 11, the General Assembly refers to contributions which United Nations organs may make to the celebration of the anniversary.

The International Law Commission, which has already made an important contribution to the work of the Organization, may wish to be associated with this celebration. To this end I would be grateful if, at the next session of the Commission, the text of resolution 2499 (XXIV) could be brought to its attention.
