DRAFT ARTICLES ON REPRESENTATIVES OF STATES TO  
INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

Text of ~~Articles~~ 5, 6 and 7 adopted by the Drafting Committee.

Article 5

Establishment of permanent missions

Member States may establish permanent missions to the Organization for the performance of the functions set forth in article 6 of the present articles.

Article 6

Functions of a permanent mission

The functions of a permanent mission consist inter alia in:

(a) representing the sending State in the Organization;

(b) keeping the necessary liaison between the sending State and the Organization;

(c) carrying on negotiations with or in the Organization;

(d) ascertaining activities and developments in the Organization, and reporting thereon to the Government of the sending State;

(e) promoting cooperation between member States and the realization of the purposes and principles of the Organization.

Article 7

Accreditation or assignment to two or more organizations

The sending State may accredit a permanent representative or assign a member of the [diplomatic] staff of the permanent mission, to two or more organizations.
