to international organizations

Text of draft articles 50 and 51
proposed by the Special Rapporteur

Article 50

Establishment of permanent Observers

Non-Member States may establish permanent Observers to the Organization for the performance of the functions set forth in article 51 of the present articles.

Article 51

Functions of permanent Observers

1. The principal function of permanent Observers is to ensure the necessary liaison between the sending State and the Organization.
2. Permanent Observers may also perform mutatis mutandis other functions of permanent missions as set forth in article 7 of the present articles.
