Commemoration of the 75th anniversary of the International Law Commission


This year, the International Law Commission celebrates its seventy-fifth anniversary with a commemorative event in Geneva. Arrangements are being made also to hold a potential further commemorative event in New York during International Law Week, which begins on 21 October 2024.

The event in Geneva will be held on 24 May 2024 at the auditorium Ivan Pictet A1B of the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies, Chemin Eugène-Rigot 2A, 1211 Geneva, Switzerland. The event will be jointly hosted by the International Law Commission and the Graduate Institute. It will begin with a reception, generously offered by the Swiss Federal Department of Foreign Affairs, and be followed by introductory remarks and three panel discussions concerning the Commission and its work.
