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— Immunité plus étendue aux organisations internationales dont la personnalité juridique se fonde sur leur caractère fonctionnel par opposition aux États étrangers — L'immunité des organisations internationales est considérée comme étant absolue dans les limites de leurs fonctions — L'immunité est valide jusqu'à ce qu'elle soit expressément levée — Une conduite passive n'est pas considérée comme constituant une renonciation tacite à l'immunité — L'immunité constitue un obstacle procédural à l'application de la loi mais n'altère pas la validité des règles de fond — La signification de documents officiels, tels que les assignations à comparaître, à des organisations internationales est faite exclusivement par l'intermédiaire des bons offices du ministère autrichien des affaires étrangères — La renonciation à l'immunité ne s'étend à aucune mesure d'exécution

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
